JEET Platform Development Work Inauguration

On Saturday 20th April 2024, Managing Director of SBI Foundation Shri Sanjay Prakash inaugurated the Platform Development of JEET, which is being done by iProgrammer Solutions Pvt Ltd., Pune.

The meeting was attended by 25 NGOs from all over India but mainly from Mumbai. These NGOs are working in the area of education – vocational and sports included. Some of the participating NGOs include all the founding member NGOs of JEET and others like Door Step School, Meghashala, Adhyayan Foundation, Ratna Nidhi Charitable Trust, Masoom Education, Sri Aurobindo Society Delhi, Fortess Chennai and Meghashala, Bengaluru among others.

The program began with a Christian and Vedantic prayer in line with the teachings of Sri Ramakrishna, 'As many faiths so many paths.' After prayer a song in praise of Swami Vivekananda was sung who gave many a golden word on Education. To recall one of his famous quotes, "I consider every man a traitor who having been educated at the expense of the poor pays not the least heed to them." Lamp lighting at the picture of Swami Vivekananda was done first by MD followed by both the Chairman and advisor of RKSSNGO, and others.



Welcome speech was given by the COO of the founder NGO Bombay Community Public Trust Ms. Utpala Thacker where she explained why JEET was formed and what are its objectives and mission. Namely, to bring quality and equity to Indian Education system and eradicate illiteracy and poor quality education.

Next, the meeting was addressed by the Working Member of JEET Sri Raghu Pilaka who is also the Director of RKSS (Ramakrishna Sarada Samiti), the anchor NGO of JEET. He introduced the audience to the many foundational works undertaken by JEET during the last year since its formation on 23-01-23 like the publication of JKA newsletters and commencing the development work of JEETs portal, which would be a free LMS platform for the under privileged and linguistically disadvantaged school children from classes 1 to 12.



This was followed by a brief presentation by iProrgrammer the software company that has been entrusted to develop JEET LMS platform with rich and free educational videos and digital lessons. Several members of the audience raised questions whether (1) The platform being developed allows content creators to post their lessons (2) Content curation means what and who does this for JEET (3) Can this be accessed by other NGOs if so how (4) Can an already developed LMS platform integrate with JEET platform, etc.

The presentation was followed by a brief speech by the advisor of RKSS Srinivas Venkatram who emphasised the importance of working as a collaborative and the challenges that JEET may face in future. How effectively the collaborative of NGOs in education will overcome them will determine its success in future.

The Chief Guest and MD SBI Foundation Sri Sanjay Prakash was the next and final speaker. Some of his important observations were as follows:





SBI Foundation manages the CSR funds and their purpose an utilisation of the State Bank of India and all its subsidiaries

SBIF supported JEET because of the unselfish work of RKSS and its Director Raghu Pilaka and the Trustees in the field of education

JEETs purpose is to provide life time free educational videos and digital lessons to children from Government schools and disadvantaged background in the hope that not only the digital divide will be shortened but quality education will also be provided at the doorstep of the under served

JEET is supposed to deliver a platform with 12000 videos and digital lessons accessible by the students as well as address the needs of 2 big educationally backwards states namely Bihar and Andhra Pradesh.

The first phase of funding will support the development of the platform, which is being inaugurated today and shall be completed in 14 months

In future SBIF will support and ensure JEET grows bigger and better catering to all states and their vernacular languages having at least 2 Lakh videos without spending substantially for video production.

Content aggregation and curation is the key to this project and JEET will surely live up to the expectation under the able leadership team.

Next a felicitation function was held where 'lamp lighters' Jyoti Tyagarajan of Meghashala and R Krishnan of VKRCE Trust were felicitated along with the founder members of JEET: Utpala Thacker COO of BCPT, Vidya Raghu Chairman of RKSS, Dymphena CEO of Muktangan, Uday Deshpande Head of Sree Samarth Vyayam Mandir, Mayappa Budhe Head of MSP Foundation, and Pramod Nigudkar, CEO of Vipla Foundation.

After felicitation there was roundtable on the topic of NGOs Accelerating by the Power of Collaboration where several heads of NGOs have expressed the need to collaborate and shared their experiences of collaboration in the field of service to the under privileged especially in Education.

The meeting ended with a few more felicitations to the staff and patrons of JEET and a vote of thanks by the Director of RKSS Shri Raghu Pilaka. The meeting was compered by the able and enthusiastic volunteer of RKSS Medhaj Madhavan. Each of the attendee carried a file with them made by the artisans of SATTVA a project of RKSS, and the gifts given away in the felicitations were also their handcrafted works. Thus the meeting ended as a grand success and we hope the bell that tolled this launch will serve as a death knell to all ignorance, and untruth – **Asatoma Satgamaya**, **Tamasoma Jyotirgamaya**.
